SENIORS WALK BENEFITTING NOVA WEST ISLAND

Montreal, Québec, May 4, 2021 — With a view to taking its vision of Making People's Lives BETTER ever further, Chartwell Retirement Residences is partnering with NOVA West Island for a fundraising event. Anyone aged 55 and up can sign up for the walk-a-thon at one of the Chartwell residences involved. A donation of \$20 per person is requested as a registration fee. Participants will receive an information package about the fundraiser and establish their own goals, which they will have one month—the duration of the event—to reach.
